## **ISSUING & USE OF MARITIME CIRCULARS**

Maritime Circulars are issued by the St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry for public information and the attention of Maritime Registrars, Shipowners, Masters, Managers & Operators of St. Kitts & Nevis Ships, Classification Societies, Recognised Organisations, Recognised Security Organisations, Surveyors of Ships & Flag State Inspectors to this Administration, Seafarers & IMO Member States.

Shipowners, Masters, Managers & Operators of St. Kitts & Nevis Ships, should ensure that these Maritime Circulars are maintained current and on board St. Kitts & Nevis Ships and that the contents of each be properly known to all persons concerned.

Recognised Organisations, Recognised Security Organisations, Surveyors of Ships & Flag State Inspectors to this Administration, should ensure that the contents of these Maritime Circulars are made known where necessary to their staff & surveyors carrying out statutory services for and on our ships.

Maritime Registrars should ensure that the contents of these Maritime Circulars are made known to their staff carrying out registration services for us and that an electronic copy is provided to all ships being registered with St. Kitts & Nevis for the first time.

Maritime Circulars will be published periodically as required and can be downloaded from the website of the St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry <a href="https://www.stkittsnevisregistry.net">www.stkittsnevisregistry.net</a> or may be requested from the office of St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry or the Department of Maritime Affairs.

Neither St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry nor its officers or staff can give legal advice. Where Maritime Circulars provide guidance on St. Kitts & Nevis or other shipping legislation, it should not be regarded as definitive. The way the law applies to any particular case can vary according to circumstances e.g. from ship to ship. Independent legal advice should be sought if one is unsure of their own legal position.
